Here we are gloves at the ready!


Our first job was to break up all the lumps in the soil with our forks and trowels, this was to make the soil a lot finer.




Once all the soil was broken down, we then made it level and one by one we each made a deep line in the soil called a 'drill'.










Our next task was to cover all of the seeds with soil, we then gently patted it down with our trowels.
