

EYFS Curriculum Overview Spring Term First half-term 2020

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

We will learn about ways to negotiate with our friends to ensure that we have happy days at school and are able to make our thoughts and feelings known in a mature way. We will work hard to persevere with learning activities, becoming more independent in completing tasks. We will practise our skills at being friendly and confident when playing our own games at playtimes.

English

We will continue with our daily phonics lessons to help us to read and write with increasing confidence. We will also receive new books to read at home. We will take part in focussed writing sessions each day to help us to become more independent in attempting to spell and write. We will study the book 'SHHH!' which will lead us into lots of traditional tales. We can't wait to perform this story to you in our Class Assembly at the end of January. We hope you feel very proud of how brave we are and how well we are learning to tell stories!

Communication and Language

We have made fantastic progress in this area! This half term it is very important that we focus on further developing our listening and attention skills. This will help us to take on board lots of new information and to concentrate well during teaching sessions. We will play memory games to help us to remember our new learning.

Mathematics

We will start the term by learning to use positional language accurately. We will then spend time embedding our skills in counting increasingly large groups of objects accurately and then comparing these to order groups of objects accurately. We will revise adding and taking away every day. We will finish the half term by learning to talk about the length and height of objects using words such as longer and shorter.

Physical Development

This half term we will focus on our fine motor skills. We will take part in handwriting sessions each day as well as activities that help to develop the muscles in our fingers, hands and arms. We will continue to be active learners outside. We will also learn to be calm and appreciate the Winter sights and sounds of the Earth all around us.

Understanding the World

We will learn about Chinese New Year; tasting traditional foods and learning a special song. We will learn to use the touch pad on our school laptops to move the cursor, click and drag and drop. We will explore Winter, taking every opportunity to experience the cold weather, ice, frost and hopefully even some snow! Please remember to dress for the weather every day!
