



## Remote Learning Plan

### Rationale:

In order to ensure that learning is continued, irrespective of lockdown and self-isolation, Henhurst Ridge Primary Academy has developed the following plan.

This plan covers three scenarios:

1. Individual child requiring Remote Learning
2. Whole Class bubble requiring Remote Learning
3. National lockdown

The plan complies with the principles outlined in the Department for Education document [Guidance for Full Opening of Schools](#) and meets the expectation of a minimum of three hours remote learning per day for primary aged children. The tables below show how this will be timetabled and considers the age and stage of the children in each year group and what would be appropriate for them to do. There will also be extension tasks or challenges for any child wanting to do more than the core offer of work set available on Teams.

Remote learning activities will consist of a combination of live lessons, recorded lesson introductions, online activities and documents/typed instructions. Live lessons will be recorded on Teams and available after the lesson if you are unable to log on at that time. Activities will be personalised to our children and support current learning and aim to limit the impact of class closure on children's learning and development. Careful consideration has been given to which learning activities are appropriate for different age groups, the length of time for each of the activities and the vehicle to deliver these.
