<u>Reading books & Home Learning</u>: Please ensure you are listening to your child read every day, it is so important. Our revised Home Learning policy will be sent home next week with a view to start it after half term. We've tried to get the balance right of practising basic skills whilst also giving a chance for the children to express their creative side! Road works on Henhurst Hill: It looks like they are nearly finished! Once they are gone, the official start time of school is 8:45am so please do all you can to be here by then.
