

### **Writing:**

We will start the term by rewriting the traditional tale 'The Three Little Pigs'. We will then be writing non-fiction newspaper reports.

### **Maths:**

As Mathematicians, we are furthering our understanding of shape by creating patterns. We are then moving our understanding of number on to numbers within 20 and applying this knowledge to addition and subtraction within 20.

### **PSHE:**

We are going to be learning how to keep ourselves safe. We will learn who in our community keeps us safe and how we can keep ourselves safe.

### **Music:**

This term, we will be exploring how music can be used to tell a story. We will identify the contrasts of fast and slow, high and low, loud and quiet – and how they can be used in a performance.

## **London's Burning** **Spring 1 2022**

This term we will be exploring the tragic yet historic event of the Great Fire of London.

### **Art & Design:**

As Artists, we will be engaging with our painting skills and colour mixing to make shades of orange. The orange paint will then be used in painting a scene from the Great Fire of London.

### **Design & Technology:**

As Designers, we will be researching the leather bucket used to extinguish fires in 1666. We will then be designing and creating our own buckets and putting them to the test!

### **Computing:**

We will be exploring how to use search engines safely and effectively to help with our research on the Great Fire of London.

### **History:**

We will be travelling back to 1666 and exploring the Great Fire of London, how it started and how it stopped. We will be learning about how it impacted the future, and about the events that unfolded on the days of the event by exploring the famous diary of Samuel Pepys.

### **Science:**

As Scientists, we will be learning about everyday materials such as wood, metal, plastic and glass. We will be discussing how these plastics are used in everyday life, how to recognise these materials and also linking our scientific research back to our historical research and think about why wooden houses were so flammable in 1666!
