Curriculum Overview

Maths

As Mathematicians, we will master the use of bar models when approaching addition and subtraction word problems. Then, we will move onto multiplication and division.

Reading

We will continue to work on a range of reading comprehension skills including skim reading and selecting relevant information and begin applying these to different types of written questions we might encounter.

Writing

This half term, we will write our own defeat the monster tale based on the Anglo-Saxon story, Beowulf. In non-fiction, we will write fact files about the ancient burial mound, Sutton Hoo.

History

In History, we will be learning to generate and answer historically valid questions using sources such as books and artefacts, We will 'zoom in' on the ancient Anglo-Saxon burial mound, Sutton Hoo.

Science

As Scientists, we will explore light and dark, learning about reflectors, opaque, transparent and translucent materials, and shadows.

PE

In PE, we will be practising ball skills such as throwing, catching and dribbling, working on our accuracy and confidence. In fitness, we will work on speed, stamina, strength, coordination, balance and agility.

Art

As Artists, we will be using light and dark colours to recreate an Anglo-Saxon illuminated letter.

Computing

In Computing, we will be learning how to use search engines to retrieve information efficiently and recapping our knowledge of staying safe online.

As Designers, we will research, design and make a shield that would have been suitable for an Anglo-Saxon in battle.
