Curriculum Overview

Maths

As mathematicians, we will continue to work on addition and subtraction within 1000, applying this to word problems and mathematical models to support mastery.

Reading

We will enjoy a wider variety of stories this half term, from Buddy's Rainforest Rescue to Cat Tales - one of Pie Corbett's reading spine favourites! We will be working on a range of VIPERS skills including summary and inference.

Writing

This half term, we will base our writing around our class book, *Charlie Small: Gorilla City*. We will be working on captivating setting descriptions and exciting instructions – does anyone need to know how to ride a rhino?

Geography

In geography, we will learn about the rainforests of the world, discovering these through a variety of geographical resources and comparing the features of different biomes.

Science

As scientists, we will explore the world of plants, learning about the purposes of their different parts, and the processes of water transportation, seed dispersal and pollination.

Art

As artists, we will explore the use of print making to create exciting and intriguing textures. This will link with our Polar Express theme, getting us into a wintery mood!

D&T

Just like Charlie Small, we've found ourselves stranded in the jungle! We will learn how to build a den, using different techniques to strengthen our structure.

Computing

Step by step, we will create a simple point-scoring game this half term.

In PE, we will study yoga, practicing our mindfulness and body awareness while learning yoga poses. We will also work on defending, attacking, throwing, catching and shooting in netball.
