Christmas Performances:

We are still going ahead with our new revised dates and times for our Christmas performances (please see a reminder below) but we are asking parents to follow the guidance that was released yesterday from the Dfe:

- Take a Lateral Flow Test before entering school and if positive DO NOT attend
- Wear a face covering at all times unless you are exempt and in which case please wear the sunflower lanyard
- Use the hand sanitiser or washing facilities on arrival
- Maintain social distancing as much as possible
- DO NOT attend if you have any of the 3 top COVID19 symptoms
- Avoid bringing younger siblings if possible, to reduce numbers

In the meantime, school will ensure the chairs are spread out as much as possible and that the hall is well ventilated.

Many schools are choosing not to host events so please do play your part in keeping everyone safe.
