Reception Home Learning: Summer I: Local Area



Home learning ideas and activities:

- Read or enjoy having read to you as many 'Traditional Tales' as you like, for example, The Three Little Pigs. Can you spot things that are the same in all the tales? Do they all have a 'baddy' and a hero? Do they all start with 'Once upon a time'? (Reading and Communication and Language)
- Write captions or sentences to describe either a goat or the troll in 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' story. Think about what they look like and if they are mean or nice! (Literacy)
- Have a go at creating St Peter's Bridge in Burton. What materials will you use? (Expressive arts and design)
- Discuss or visit a place of worship. Discuss with a grown-up why these places may be special to people. Do you have a special place to worship? Why is it special to you? (Understanding the World and Communication and Language)
- Draw and colour/paint four tress to represent Autumn, Winter, Spring and Summer. What colour will the leaves be on your trees? Why have you decided to use those colours? Think about our learning on seasons. (Understanding the World)

Reading:

Please read the book sent home in your child's reading wallet daily or every other day. Please ensure you sign the reading record and send it into school daily so we know that the book has been read and can then change it. Books will be changed every Thursday. Your child will also benefit from practising their speed sounds daily.

<u>Maths Facts!</u>

With your child, continue to practise:

- Number bonds to 5 or 10, e.g: 2 + 3 = 5 6 + 4 = 10
- Counting to or beyond 20
- Number formation
- ABAB or ABB patterns, for example: red, green, red green / yellow, yellow, red, yellow, yellow red.
- Matching numerals to amounts, for example, identifying the number 9 and finding 9 objects.
