English

As Authors, we will be writing a warning tale based on the text 'Kassim and the greedy dragon', thinking about how to use different sentence types to create effect. We will then be writing an explanation text to explain why dragons are extinct. Finally, we will finish off the year looking at poetry inspired by Michael Rosen.

Maths

As Mathematicians, we will be deepening our understanding of division looking at sharing and grouping into each groups. We will be developing our fractions knowledge and begin to increase our understanding of pattern and 2D or 3D shapes.

Reading

As readers, we will be exploring a range of engaging texts. We will be working on developing our reading skills of prediction, inference and retrieval. We will be looking at the texts including The Child's garden, Grandad's Island and The Tin Forest.

RE
