

# Year 1/2 Home Learning: Autumn 1: Ocean Adventures



## Home learning ideas and activities:

- Read or enjoy having read to you as many 'Journey Tales' as you like e.g. The Snail and the Whale, Handa's Surprise, Peace at Last. Can you spot things that are the same in all the tales? Where do the main characters journey to? What problems do they encounter? Do they overcome the problem? (Reading)
- Create a fact file about your favourite ocean animal? Can you tell us a WOW fact? (Writing)
- Use different sources e.g. books, the internet to find out about ocean animals and their habitats. (Science)
- Can you name the seven world continents and the five oceans? Can you locate these on a map, atlas or globe? (Geography)
- Create a piece of ocean craft or art. You could paint or draw an underwater scene (turn over for some ideas!) (Art and D&T)

## Reading:

Please read the book sent home in your child's reading wallet daily. This is so important as it helps your child to access the whole curriculum. Please ensure you sign the reading record and send it into school daily so we know that the book has been read and can then change it.

Your child will also benefit from practising the speed sounds in their reading books daily.

## Maths Facts!

Year 1

With your child, continue to practise:

- Counting forwards and backwards from numbers between 0 – 20.
- Writing these numbers in numerals and words e.g. 2 two
- Use objects to practice addition and subtraction within 20.

Year 2

With your child, continue to practise:

- Number bonds to 20 e.g. 2 and 18
- Practice your 2, 5 and 10 times tables
- Measuring length in cm and mm.
