Home Learning Ideas:

- Create a quiz about mountains using knowledge you have learnt in school and any interesting facts you have researched at home. (Geography)
- Cook a healthy packed lunch. Research where your food has come from. (D&T)
- Create a model of the different types of teeth using recycled objects. (Science)
- Design an outfit for a mountaineer. (Art)
- Write your own tale of fear. (Writing)
- Read a book and write a book review to share with the class (Reading). Some books linked to our topic: Mimi and the Mountain Dragon; Bigfoot Mountain; High as a Hawk.
- Use the World Wide Web to research something that you are interested with. Write an information text based on what you have researched (Computing & Writing)
- Reflect on something you did well on last year and set yourself a goal for this year. (PSHE)

Maths Facts! With your child...

- Practise counting in 3s, 4s and 8s
- Practise rapid recall (within 6 seconds) of times table facts
- Practise using the commutative law to answer multiplication tables (i.e. $a \times b = b \times a$)
- Practise addition and subtraction of 2 and 3 digit numbers
