We are very much looking forward to showing off our lovely school and the even lovelier children in it!

#### <u>New pupils:</u>

A huge welcome to our new Reception and Nursery intake. They have settled in so brilliantly and it already feels like they have always been part of our school community. We also welcome some other children who have joined us in other year groups. A very warm welcome to siblings Scarlet and Rarnell into Year 2, Moosa into Year 1 and his sister Jawariah into Year 2 and finally Hanzalah into Year 3. Our school community continues to grow and flourish! Welcome to you all, we hope you will be very happy here with us! Nut free and snacks at playtime: Thank you for the support we've had at becoming a nut free school. If you have any questions about this, please don't hesitate to contact the school office. Early Years and Key Stage 1 do not need to bring a snack in as they are provided with free fruit. Key Stage 2 children are allowed to bring a <u>HEALTHY</u> snack in (please no chocolate or crisps). It would be really helpful if these were in a separate labelled container or bag and not in their lunch boxes. The children only have a 15-minute playtime and by the time they have queued up to get to their lunchbox and retrieve their snack, a lot of their free time has gone. Thank you for any help that you can give with this.
